**Eighty-four percent** of Americans believe citizens should be allowed to have any breed of dog they choose\*, and we agree!

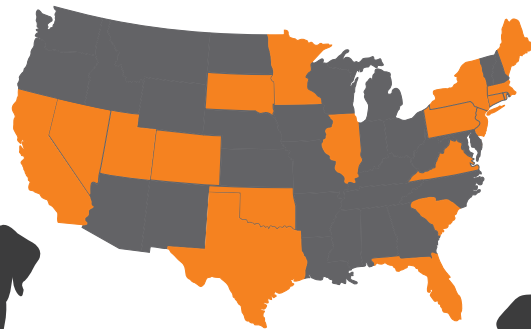
